For pregnant women, [messenger RNA vaccines](#), such as the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines, will be used, since there is more data on the safety of these vaccines during pregnancy. Pregnant women can [make an appointment online](#).

Pregnant women always have the option, if they wish, of contacting a health professional, such as their attending physician, to discuss the risks of COVID-19 and the benefits and potential risks of vaccination.
